To make your board experience run smoothly, please read the following carefully:

Let us know as much in advance as possible when to expect your horse so that we can be properly prepared for your visit. **Please no arrivals or departures after 6pm.**

Please keep speed to 10mph down our driveway and, **DEAD SLOW** in the barn area.

Due to Insurance Requirements, Pets Must Remain In Your Vehicle.

Upon arrival:

1) Check the white board outside the office in Barn Aisle 2 for your stall assignment. There will be a clip board with (PSERC) forms and also the Ranch forms.

2) Fill out all paperwork legibly, and sign and initial where indicated. Hang the clip board back on the stall. **Please Note: No horse may be admitted without all paperwork being completed and signed, together with the deposit. If you are having your horse delivered, please arrange to fill out forms ahead of time and have the forms and deposit check sent with your horse.**

3) If your horse is expected to stay **5 days or less, please put a \$100 deposit** check made out to **Mission Equine**, in the office **drop box**.

4) If your horse is expected to stay **6 days or more, please put the \$100 deposit AND the signed Visa authorization** in the **drop box**. (Think of this as booking a hotel room for your horse). Credit cards will be charged every 15 days if there is a balance owing. You may also pay by check if you let us know.

Upon Departure:

5) Your visa will be charged the balance of board when your horse departs or at the end of each month, or every 15 days, whichever is appropriate. You may choose to settle your account by check if you wish, and your visa authorization will be destroyed. If you would like this option, please just let us know. Board bills must be paid in full before your horse leaves the facility. Please take care of your payment **before** loading your horse.
